The Winnipeg Philharmonic Choir has a **limited number of \$500 bursaries available** for qualified post-secondary students for the rehearsal period leading up to its performances with the WSO of Faure's *Requiem* and Poulenc's *Gloria*, on March 23, 24 and 25, 2018.

Successful candidates will be awarded a \$500 bursary based on completion of the following:

- Tuesday evening rehearsals Jan 9 – Mar 20, 2018, 7-9:45pm (unless otherwise advised, rehearsals take place at Kelvin High School, 155 Kingsway)
- Special rehearsal (Date/time/venue TBA)
- WSO Rehearsals Wed Mar 21 and Thu Mar 22 7-9:30pm (at St Boniface Cathedral)
- Concerts with WSO (at St Boniface Cathedral)
 - Friday Mar 23 at 7pm (choristers must arrive by 5:30pm)
 - Saturday Mar 24 at 7pm (choristers must arrive by 5:30pm)
 - Sunday Mar 25 at 3pm (choristers must arrive by 1:30pm)

The bursary will be awarded in three installments: \$150 in January 2018, \$150 in February 2018, and \$200 at the final performance in March, 2018.
